BAC FACULTY SCHOLARS PROGRAM

The faculty scholars program is open to promising junior and senior business students. Selected students receive a \$1,000 grant and the opportunity to conduct research under the direction of an expert research professor.

The Business Advisory Council (BAC), a group of distinguished business leaders who guide and support the College, funds the program. All scholarships are for one semester and subject to renewal based upon successful completion of assignments and availability of funds.

Assignments vary by professor. Hours required of students should not exceed ten hours a week. Students must provide mid-semester and end-of-semester reports on their research projects. All participants must reapply each semester to be considered.

REQUIREMENTS

- A minimum of 3.0 cumulative USM GPA
- Junior or senior standing
- Full time student (12 + semester hours)
- Two letters of recommendation from professors
- A two-page essay describing why the applicant would be a good choice and how he or she plans to use the experience to further career goals.
