The University of Southern Mississippi invites applications for five positions: one position as Gulf Coast P-12 Educational Administration Coordinator, one position in P-12 Educational Administration, one position in School Counseling, one position as College Student Personnel Services Coordinator, and one position College Student Personnel Services.

Minimum qualifications for each position are listed below. Preference will be given to those candidates with significant successful teaching experience at the graduate level and other accomplishments justifying appointment as graduate faculty. Qualified candidates must possess an earned doctorate in the appropriate field of study. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.

These are all nine-month, tenure-track positions with expectations for summer employment. Starting date is August 2008, but the preferred start date is May 2008 for the summer session. Applications will not be considered complete until the following materials are received by the search committee chair: application letter indicating position of interest, current curriculum vitae, transcripts, three *current* reference letters and copies of recent teaching evaluations for applicants with prior teaching experience.
