- 15 ACT/2.5 GPA
- Not With Full Pell
- \$250=Freshman/ Sophomores,
 \$500=Junior/Senior per semester
- 8 Total Semesters

Returning Students

- Successfully Completed 15 Credits Prior Semester (not including summer)
- Maintain Cumulative 2.5 gpa
- Complete the FAFSA

MESG

- Sept 15 Deadline
- 29 ACT/3.5 GPA
- \$1250/ Semester
- Fall/Spring Only
- Apply within 3 years of High School
- 8 Total Semesters

Returning Students

- Successfully Completed 15 Credits Prior Semester (not including summer)
- Maintain Cumulative 3.5 gpa
- Complete the FAFSA

HELP

- March 15 Deadline
- 20 ACT/2.5 GPA
- Income Limitations
- Covers Full Tuition \$
- Fall/Spring Only
- Apply within 1 year of High School
- 8 Total Semesters

Returning Students

- Successfully Completed 15 Credits Prior Semester (not including summer)
- Maintain Cumulative 2.5 gpa
- Complete the FAFSA
- Meet Income Limitations
- State Aid funds are not received by USM until mid- semester, October 15th for the Fall and March 15th for the Spring. It will show in SOAR as pending until funds are received
- You must renew your State Aid Application each year, just like the FAFSA
- Make sure you add USM as your college preference or we will not be sent your award information
- Regaining Eligibility. Example: Student did not attend Fall 2022 but is enrolling Spring 2023. Would not be eligible Spring 2023, but if they submit 23-24 Application by the deadline, maintain cumulative GPA, and completed 15 credits Spring 2023, they may be eligible Fall 2023
