

## 015-020 Procurement Limits Policies: IHLs

### Procedures for the Acquisition of Information Technology Equipment, Software, and Services by Procurement Type and Total Lifecycle Cost for Institutions of Higher Learning

By law, all acquisitions of information technology products or services by IHLs must be approved by ITS. ITS has delegated this responsibility to the State's Institutions of Higher Learning for certain types of purchases and lifecycle cost limits. Please note that these thresholds are based upon **total lifecycle costs** and that **there are situations in which actual monies paid is not the sole determinant of the requirement for a competitive procurement process**. For purchases in which (1) the value of the goods and services exceeds bid limit, (2) there is a competitive market, and (3) there is potential for vendor profit from the project, contracts must be awarded based on an open and competitive process that allows the state to compare offerings to obtain the best product, service, and value, regardless of monies paid directly to the vendor by the state entity. The competitive process ensures the state's requirements are well-defined, project contracts are negotiated to protect the state's interest, and the vendor selected is the one with the most advantageous combination of cost and services.

The only statutory exception to the requirement for ITS approval is for acquisitions of computer equipment and services made by IHLs wholly with federal funds. These acquisitions do NOT fall within ITS' purview.

The table below defines the procedures and the required approvals for each category and project lifecycle cost range. For current Director Approval thresholds, see Section 018-030.
