Other topics covered will be creating relationships and the importance of enhancing communication through interactions which will involve facilitating hands-on learning.

Facilitating Hands-On Learning for Infants and Toddlers at Risk, February 24, 2009, 6 - 8 p.m.

Typical development and red flags for children 3 months to 3 years of age will be discussed along with ideas on setting up the learning environment. Other topics covered will be creating relationships and the importance of enhancing communication through interactions which will involve facilitating hands-on learning.
