Spring 2010 Course information:

Students are required to enroll for a minimum of 13 credit hours and a maximum of 19 credit hours. You will receive verification of your application. Once accepted students will receive a schedule of classes and description of each course offered for the upcoming semester. At that time, you will need to choose your courses. Schedule changes may be made during the first week of classes at the Abbey.

- French language (at all levels - 3 credits),

- Ambassador Series (1 credit – required for all students)

Application Procedure:

1. Return completed application with \$250 deposit to secure your space
2. Non-Southern Miss students should have their registrar send official transcripts to The Abbey Program, The University of Southern Mississippi, 118 College Drive #10047, Hattiesburg, MS 39406-0001.
3. Currently enrolled Southern Miss students are not required to submit a transcript. Use this form (**not SOAR**) to register

Eligibility:

Minimum program eligibility requirements include the completion of at least 14 semester hours with an overall 2.0 GPA. All students must be in clear academic standing. Prior knowledge of French is not necessary. All courses are taught in English (with the exception of French language classes). It is highly recommended to take a French language course while at the Abbey. First semester freshman will be given preliminary acceptance, pending review of their university transcript.

2. \$1,250 Housing deposit **nonrefundable** due December 1, 2009. Students may pay by cash, check, or credit card, or your student account may be billed. Any interest charges resulting from charges to your student account will be student’s responsibility.
3. Final program payment is due December 15, 2009, unless proof of financial aid is provided
