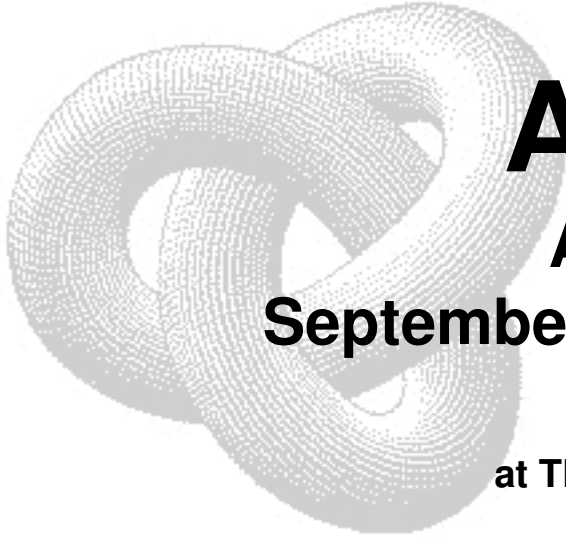

Title: Using the \LaTeX and the USM Dissertation/Thesis Package

Topic:

This provides an introduction to using \LaTeX from basics to intermediate level, and provides an introduction to creating documents for mathematics using \LaTeX . The tutorials also cover the use of the USMDiss standard doctoral dissertation and masters thesis package which is supported by the Department of Mathematics. The format also can be used by the Honors College for Honors preparing Honors Theses.

The USMDiss template satisfies the requirements of the Graduate School for publishing dissertations and theses, providing students an alternative to using standard non-technical editors. The format also provides a variance to the several Graduate School requirements for producing the document, e.g., having no right justification, and the use of Roman numerals in chapter titles, many of which are inappropriate for a mathematics document.
