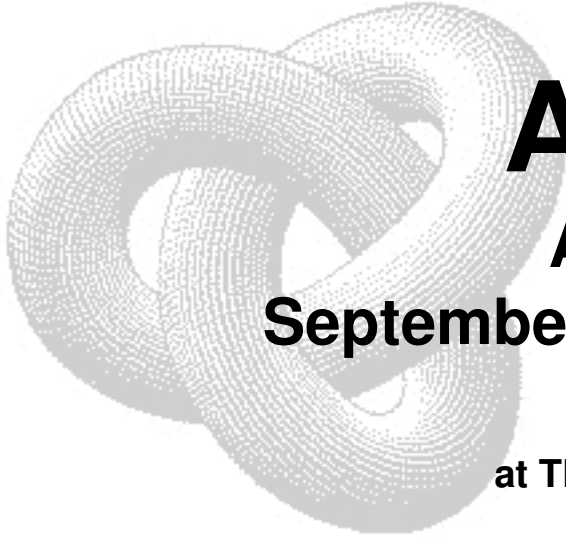

### **Title: Using Linux**

### **Topic:**

This tutorial provides an introduction to using Linux for students unfamiliar with using Unix, and provides an introduction to navigating and connecting with the network of Linux servers in the Department of Mathematics.

Topics covered include Unix basics, a discussion of the software available and how to find out about using it, mathematical and computational software, how to use ssh for connections, how to backup your files, how to customize your desktop, how to remotely connect to the servers, and how to utilize both low bandwidth and high bandwidth connections efficiently.
