Registration Information

Registration will be by both “mail-in” and “walk-in.”

Mailed forms postmarked between January 2 - 15 will be considered as they are received on a first-come, first-served basis. Checks or credit card information must be mailed with the registration forms. Registration forms postmarked before January 2 will be processed after January 15. Therefore, it is to your advantage to wait until January 2 to mail in your forms.

Walk-in registration will begin on January 8, and will be considered on a first-come, first served basis along with the mail-in forms. Forms cannot be processed while you wait because of the high volume.

We welcome and encourage registration for both terms of our five-week classes, seminars and field trips.

Payment is due at time of registration.

Classes and seminars will be cancelled two weeks prior to the start date if minimum enrollments are not met.

REFUND POLICY

Classes and Seminars

- In the event OLLI cancels classes or seminars, an OLLI credit or refund can be applied.
- A credit will be applied or a refund may be issued to an individual if the request is received by the OLLI office at least five working days prior to the beginning date of the activity.

Field Trips

- In the event OLLI cancels a field trip, a credit or a refund may be issued.
- If an individual request is received by the OLLI office at least 35 working days prior to the field trip, a credit or refund may be issued. See specific field trip description for cancellation deadlines for individual trips.
