

National Student Clearinghouse

The National Student Clearinghouse (NSC) is The University of Southern Mississippi's agent for confirming the enrollment status of financial aid recipients. The Office of the University Registrar provides periodic reports on the enrollment status of its students to the NSC.

The NSC process identifies those borrowers who

- withdraw from school and need to begin repayment.
- return to school and may be eligible for a deferment.
- continue in school and are eligible for a deferment extension.
- graduate.

In accordance with FERPA, the National Student Clearinghouse is designated by The University of Southern Mississippi as a school official with legitimate educational interests.
