 - Paper may not exceed three (3) pages, including a summary budget (title, your name, & contact information may be placed on a 4th page if needed)
 - Save as Word or PDF file
 - Attach file (in Word or PDF format) to e-mail message and send to sponsoredprograms@usm.edu no later than **8 A.M. Monday, April 27**

Deadlines:

- **Concept papers** due to SPA by **8:00 A.M. Monday, April 27**
- **Letter of Intent** [required] due at NSF by 5:00 pm Friday, May 19
- **Full proposal** (only 1 from USM) due at NSF by 5:00 pm Thursday, June 29
