



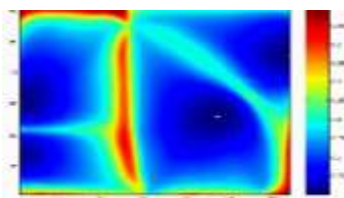

Junior Faculty!

The **Ralph E. Powe Junior Faculty Enhancement Awards** provide research seed money to junior faculty at **Oak Ridge Associated Universities (ORAU)** member institutions (*includes Southern Miss*). Full-time assistant professors within 2 years of their initial tenure-track appointment (2/5/2008 through 2/5/2010) at the time of application are eligible. Research projects must be in one of the following 5 disciplines:

- **Engineering & Applied Science**
- **Life Sciences**
- **Mathematics / Computer Sciences**
- **Physical Sciences**
- **Policy, Management, or Education**



Because ORAU & Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL) work closely together, the Award Committee emphasizes interaction with ORNL. Substantive interdisciplinary research & inter-institutional research partnerships will be very positive factors in the review process.

Because each ORAU member institution may submit only two (2) applications, *Southern Miss* is holding an internal competition to select the University's applicants.
