MEMORANDUM FOR AFROTC DET 432 AND DET 006 CADETS

SUBJECT: Requirements for Uniform Issue and Wear to Cadets

- 1. The following memorandum outlines my guidance on milestones that must be achieved before uniforms are issued to first year cadets.
- 2. To be eligible for any uniform issue/wear a cadet must:
 - a. Be fully registered for all required AFROTC courses to include cross-town institutions.
 - b. Be in good academic and military standing (ie. no conditional events) the semester immediately preceding uniform issue.
- 3. Physical Training Gear (PTGs) issue:
 - a. Meet all requirements in paragraph two.
 - b. Pass the Body Mass Index Assessment.
 - c. Cadets will be issued their first set of PTGs after completing requirements 3a. 3b. Cadets will be issued two additional PTGs upon POC Selection Process (PSP) and receive an additional (fourth) set of PTGs before departing for Field Training (FT).
- 4. Operational Camouflage Pattern (OCPs) and all Blues combinations issue:
 - a. Meet all requirements in paragraphs two and three.
 - b. Complete the Department of Defense Medical Examination Review Board (DoDMERB) exams (both optometry and physical).
 - c. Complete one full semester in the program.
 - d. Register for a second semester in the program.
 - e. Attempt the Air Force Officer Qualifying Test (AFOQT).

- f. Cadets selected for FT will be issued two additional sets of OCPs (blouse, trousers, T-shirts, socks). In total, cadets will have three sets of OCPs (blouse, trousers, shirts, and socks) and one pair of boots prior to attending FT.
- g. Cadets participating in Veteran's Vigil or Color Guard activities will be issued a service coat.
- 5. Once issued, cadets will wear uniforms In Accordance With (IAW) Department of the Air Force Instruction (DAFI) 36-2903, AFROTCI 36-2011v3, Operations Order of the week, and Aerospace Studies Classroom syllabus.
- 6. I retain the authority to change this guidance at any time due to operational constraints or situational prudence. I will also exercise the authority to restrict cadets from uniform wear IAW AFROTCI 36-2011v3 if necessary.
