What are ambassadors?

The School of Biological, Environmental, and Earth Sciences Ambassadors are a group of volunteers that enjoy promoting USM and the School of BEES. What are the requirements?

- Must have at least a 3.0 GPA
- Enrolled full time at USM
- Can serve both fall and spring semesters
- Pursuing a degree in either Biological Sciences (including all emphasis areas), Geology, Geography, Marine Biology, or Medical Laboratory Sciences.
- Must be able to attend monthly meetings at 5pm on Mondays
- Must assist with at least 3 activities per semester
- Sophomores, juniors, seniors, and graduate students are welcomed to apply.

How do I apply?

Submit application to TEC 103 by **September 28 at 5pm.**

One letter of recommendation from a professor is required.

Applicants selected for interviews will be notified by October 5.
