Students working toward the Citizen Scholars distinction at Southern Miss may work with faculty to propose an additional service-learning project to any course. The contract must be completed prior to the Add/Drop Date of the course and submitted to cce@usm.edu, 116 Harkins Hall, or Box 5211.

Service should:

- support the attainment of one or more academic course objectives
- address a community-identified (local, regional, global) need
- be a minimum of 15 hours, which may be planning a project, producing a product, or serving at a site

Learning should:

- involve structured student reflection on the service experience and its relation to course goals and/or the discipline
- involve reciprocity between course and community that has the potential to result in students' enhanced sense of personal values and civic responsibility
