<sup>1</sup>Candidates are admitted to the teacher education program after completion of required coursework and after meeting minimum state requirements for admission into teacher education programs. These state requirements include minimum scores on the ACT, SAT, or Praxis Core exams as well as a minimum GPA on core curriculum coursework at the university. Due to the requirements for admittance into the teacher education programs and data limitations on reporting periods, graduate rate is determined by a two-year completion rate upon the time of admittance to the program.
