Moffitt Health Center (Hattiesburg)

- Full service urgent care clinic with some preventative services offered
- Laboratory and x-ray services available
- Located on the first floor of Scott Hall (part of Century Park South) and open 5 days a week
- Faculty and staff can expect to pay a co-pay and deductible. Amount for these will depend upon the patient's insurance policy and coverage benefits.
 - Employees who have BCBS are entitled to an annual "Healthy You" visit/lab work free of charge
- Full-service pharmacy on site
- Medication(s) can be filled at the pharmacy inside the clinic. Outside prescriptions are welcomed.
- Pharmacy delivery program available to faculty and staff

Gulf Park Health Center





Eagle Alert

To ensure the safety of students, faculty and staff, The University of Southern Mississippi offers the Eagle Alert emergency notification system.

Students, faculty and staff can <u>update their contact information</u> to receive time-sensitive emergency messages via text and voice messages to cell phones and home phones. Eagle Alert allows the university to better inform the campus community of imminent danger and emergency situations.

While it is strongly recommended that you provide at least one phone number (cell number is recommended) for Eagle Alert, students, faculty and staff can <u>opt-out</u> of the personal phone and text message portion of the services. Although you may opt-out of those portions of the service, participation by campus email is required. You may also opt-in to receive alerts by campus phone.

Eagle Alert is a secure system, and messages will be sent through the system only in an emergency and for periodic testing. It will not be used to send advertising or spam to personal phones.

As a key partner in university governance, the Faculty Senate has responsibility for the following


(1) Facilitating meaningful input regarding matters of faculty concern


(2) Advising on policy, development, planning and budgeting, resource allocation, and operations of the university
