

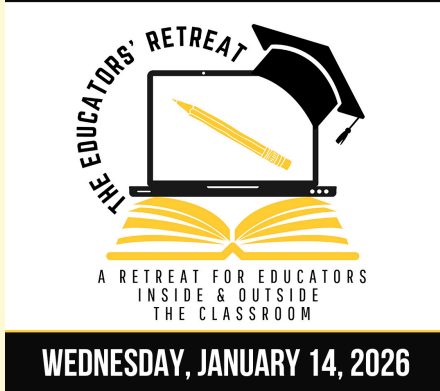

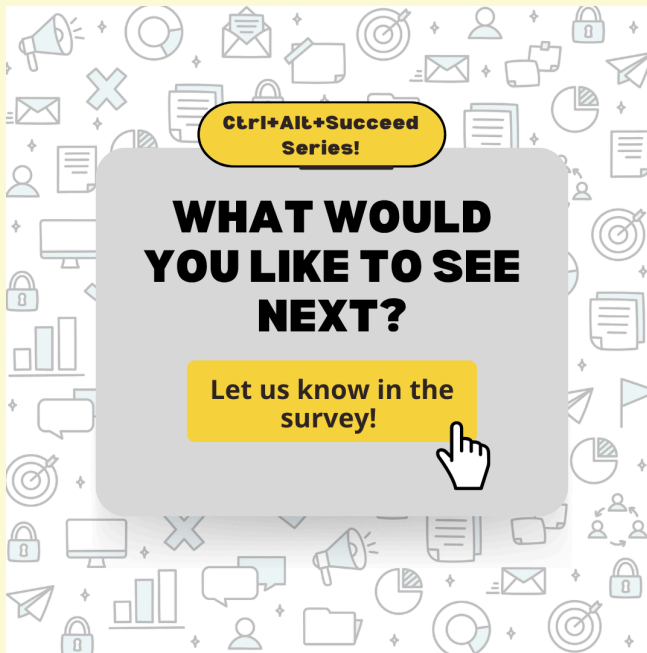

USM Service-Learning Faculty Fellows Program

USM's Center for Community Engagement accepts 6 faculty each year to participate in the Service-Learning Faculty Fellows program, in which faculty meet weekly during the spring semester to learn about service-learning pedagogy and redesign an academic course to include a service-learning component. Faculty Fellows receive \$2400 to teach the initial service-learning course within 1.5 years of seminar completion
