Kicking Off the Academic Year: Highlights from Our Preseason



Just like our Golden Eagles gearing up for a winning season with Coach Huff, we kicked off the fall semester with purpose and momentum. At the Center for Faculty Development, the start of a new academic year is our season opener—and this year's kickoff was a resounding success!

We welcomed nearly 70 new faculty members on August 1st, giving them a head start to learn our campus playbook. Three half-days of New Faculty Orientation, organized by the Office of the Provost, provided a strong foundation for their journey at USM to explore key campus resources, understand essential policies, and begin building their USM community.

To support all faculty and staff in launching the semester with confidence, we hosted two professional development series. Our summer series, *Plan, Prepare, and Engage*, featured 12 sessions packed with practical tips, new technologies, Canvas tutorials, and campus resource refreshers—drawing a record attendance of 96 participants. During *Fall*

First Week, our Educators' Retreat offered 13 engaging sessions, with 99 attendees joining us for a morning of learning, collaboration, and setting the tone for a successful academic season.

We also celebrated the achievements of our ACUE course-takers from the past academic year who crossed the goal line. Eighteen faculty members earned their Certificate in the Effective Teaching Practices Framework, and eleven earned the Advanced Certificate—an incredible accomplishment!

Finally, we wrapped up the summer with a campus-wide social at the Touchdown Club, bringing together colleagues to reconnect and recharge before the semester began. We're incredibly grateful to all the presenters who shared their expertise and to every attendee who brought energy and curiosity to our events. Your participation makes our work meaningful and our campus stronger. As we head into the academic year, we wish you a season full of wins—in the classroom, in your scholarship, and in your community. Let's make this year a championship run. Southern Miss To The Top!



New Life Skills Workshop Series for Students


