- Sept 15 Deadline
- 15 ACT/2.5 GPA
- Fall/Spring Only
- \$250/semester < 60 Credits
- \$500/semester > 60 Credits
- Not With Full Pell
- 8 Total Semesters

#### **Returning Students**

- Successfully Completed 12 Credits Prior Semester (not including summer)
- Maintain Cumulative 2.5 gpa
- Complete the FAFSA

## **MESG**

- Sept 15 Deadline
- 29 ACT/3.5 GPA
- Fall/Spring Only
- \$1250/ Semester
- Apply within 3 years of High School
- 8 Total Semesters

#### **Returning Students**

- Successfully Completed 12 Credits Prior Semester (not including summer)
- Maintain Cumulative 3.5 gpa
- Complete the FAFSA

## **HELP**

- March 31 Deadline
- 20 ACT/2.5 GPA
- Fall/Spring Only
- Covers Full Tuition \$
- Income Limitations
- Apply within 1 year of High School
- 8 Total Semesters

#### **Returning Students**

- Successfully Completed 12 Credits Prior Semester (not including summer)
- Maintain Cumulative 2.5 gpa
- Complete the FAFSA
- Meet Income Limitations



- State Aid funds are not received by USM until mid- semester, October 15<sup>th</sup> for the Fall and March 15<sup>th</sup> for the Spring. It will show in SOAR as pending until funds are received
- You must renew your State Aid Application each year, just like the FAFSA
- Make sure you add USM as your college preference or we will not be sent your award information
- Regaining Eligibility. Example: Student did not attend Fall 2025 but is enrolling Spring 2026. Would not be eligible Spring 2026, but if they submit 26-27 Application by the deadline, maintain cumulative GPA, and completed 12 credits Spring 2026, they may be eligible Fall 2026
