




### What are CIP Codes?





### Classification of Instructional Programs Codes

- Taxonomic scheme: 2-digit, 4-digit, 6-digit codes
- Each code has an associated title and definition
- Developed by the US Department of Education's
  - National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) in 1980
- NCES reviews and modifies every 10 years

#### Detail for CIP Code 01



Title: AGRICULTURAL/ANIMAL/PLANT/VETERINARY SCIENCE AND RELATED FIELDS.

**Definition:** Instructional programs that focus on agriculture, animal, plant, veterinary, and related sciences and that prepares individuals to apply specific knowledge, methods, and techniques to the management and performance of agricultural and veterinary operations.

#### Detail for CIP Code 01.05

Title: Agricultural and Domestic Animal Services.

**Definition:** Instructional content for this group of programs is defined in codes 01.0504 - 01.0599.



### Detail for CIP Code 01.0509



Title: Farrier Science.

**Definition:** A program of study that prepares individuals to become specialists in equine hoof care (farriers). Includes instruction in equine science, equine health and first aid, general horseshoeing, corrective horseshoeing, gait analysis, and metal forging techniques using gas or coal.



IHL Academic Program Inventory



- Every time we propose, modify, or retire a degree or certificate, the IHL reviews it and requires a CIP code to classify it correctly.
- IHL requires us to submit course data, including course CIP codes.
- Program CIP determines:
  - Which peer programs across the state we're compared to.
  - How it's counted in IHL's reports to the Governor's Office, Legislature, and federal agencies.

Taxpayers should know which graduates experience wage growth before investing taxpayer dollars into degree programs. Students should do the same.

As Mississippi's economy moves forward, its workforce needs change. Changing economic needs contribute to the income growth—or shrinkage—for public university graduates who work in Mississippi.<sup>8</sup> Analysts reviewed each degree program at Mississippi's public universities to determine how our state's economy has valued them over time.

One example of a degree program with significant income growth for graduates working in Mississippi has been Construction Management. These graduates boasted the largest entry-level income growth of any degree program from 2008 to 2020—from \$37,626 to \$60,859.9 The median entry-level income for these Construction Management graduates increased by nearly 40%—nearly five times more than the median income for other new graduates increased during the same time. However, our state's public universities only produced 38 Construction Management graduates from 2015 to 2017 while approximately 1,400 entry-level Construction Management jobs were available in 2022. Figure 3 shows the degree programs with graduates who experienced the most dramatic entry-level income growth over time.

### STATE AND FEDERAL REPORTING: IPEDS

- The Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) is the primary source of official data about U.S. colleges and universities.
  - Every institution that receives federal financial aid (Title IV funding) is required by law to submit data to IPEDS each year.
- When the university reports to IPEDS, all enrollments, degrees, and completions are categorized by CIP.
  - This is how the federal government determines how many degrees are awarded nationwide, as "major" names are not always consistent across institutions.

### STATE AND FEDERAL REPORTING: IPEDS


- CIP code selection is important for IPEDS reporting because we want our programs and activities to be accurately compared against other similar programs.
- An inaccurate CIP can result in imbalanced comparisons that do not properly demonstrate our achievements.



### Title IV Funding Requirement:

- Degree production is reported at the individual student level based on CIP & credential (i.e., degree type).
- USM is required to submit this information to receive Title IV funding.
- Graduation data "lags;" in 2023-2024, data from 2015-2019 was submitted.

### Gainful Employment:

- At the individual student-level, compare student's degree (6-digit CIPs), debt, and income (using tax records) to produce a ratio.
- Future initiative is to flag programs that do not meet set thresholds and take away Title IV funding.

USM compares faculty salaries (by discipline employed under – i.e., discipline CIP) to other faculty salaries in the southern region of the U.S.

### NATIONAL COMPARISONS: FACULTY SALARY MARKET ANALYSIS EXAMPLE

Combined Disciplines: Anthropology and Sociology

<u>Discipline CIP</u>: 45.0201 (Anthropology)

Market salary average for Anthropology (45.0201) = \$81,000

Market salary average for Sociology (45.1101) = \$98,000



Sociology faculty receive a lower salary compared to the national average.



In Fall 2024, *Anthropology and Sociology* was split into two disciplines: *Anthropology* (45.0201) and *Sociology* (45.1101).





### STEM DESIGNATIONS: INTERNATIONAL ADMISSIONS

Department of Homeland Security STEM Designated Degree Program List

- STEM designated degrees allow international students to remain in and work in the US for up to 3 years post-graduation without sponsorship.
- STEM designation is based on CIP code.

Example: Computational Sciences PhD

Modified CIP code in AY 2024-2025. Curriculog proposal memo:

"The current CIP code, 11.9999, does not reflect the curriculum of the program, in either title or definition. Furthermore, as this code is not classified as a STEM CIP code by DHS, its international graduates can only have 1 year of OPT, rather than 3 years for a STEM code. We request a change to a CIP code that has a title that exactly matches that of the program, and a definition that is consistent with the program's curriculum. As indicated in recent assessment reports, our recent output of graduates has been low; we believe a change to the CIP code will be helpful for recruitment, particularly of international students."

### Faculty Qualifications

### FACULTY QUALIFICATIONS

- When reviewing Faculty Qualifications Forms, we compare the CIP codes of faculty degrees and the CIP code associated with course prefixes.
- Each school produces a list of appropriate <u>standard qualification</u> CIP codes per prefix.
  - This does not mean you must have one of the standard CIPs, just that your degree will not be considered terminal without the correct CIP.


