- Can you please confirm whether the prime bidder may use a Mississippi electrical subcontractor for installation, and whether there are any specific registration, licensing, insurance, or subcontractor documentation requirements that should be submitted with the bid?
 - Contractors and subcontractors performing installation/construction services on state property follow the typical rules. They all must be registered and in good standing with the Mississippi Secretary of State. I don't know how much "construction" will be involved to install these charging stations, but the prime contractor should also be licensed through the Mississippi board of contractors.
- We would also like to know the process for arranging a site assessment before the September 1 bid deadline.

 - Please remember the exact placement of the stations will only be finalized after the bids are addressed, the visit will only show potential placement options.
