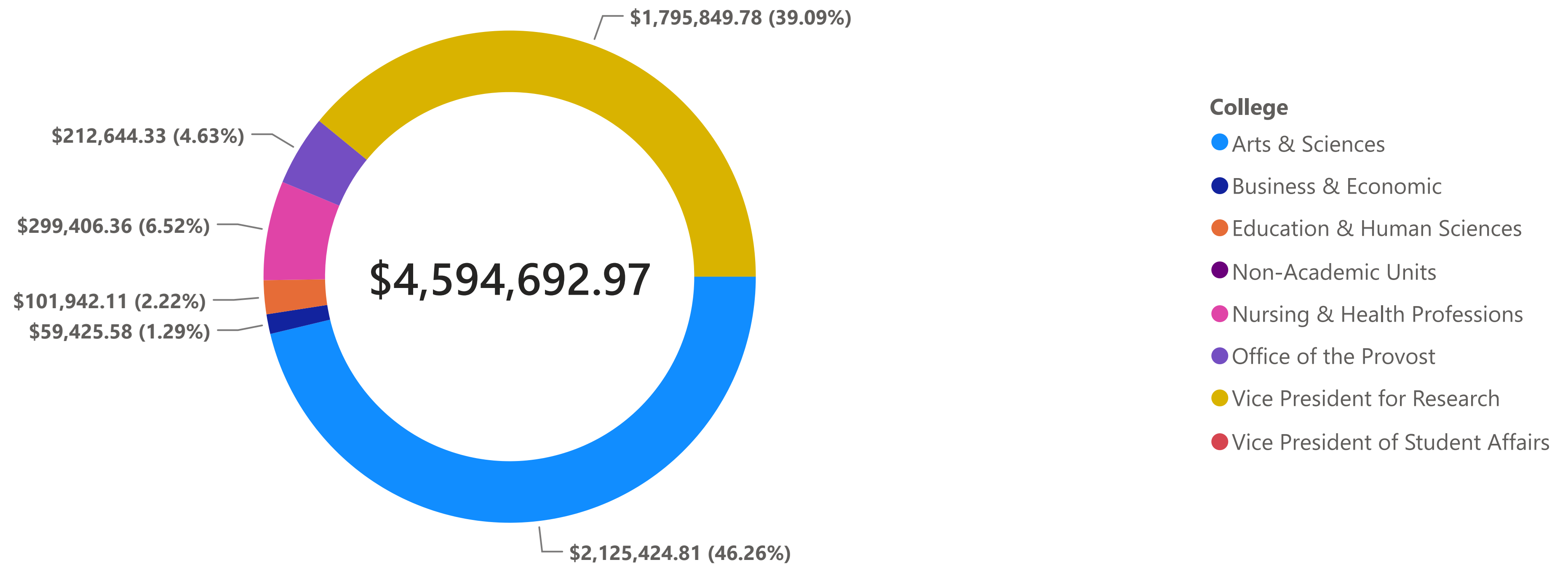

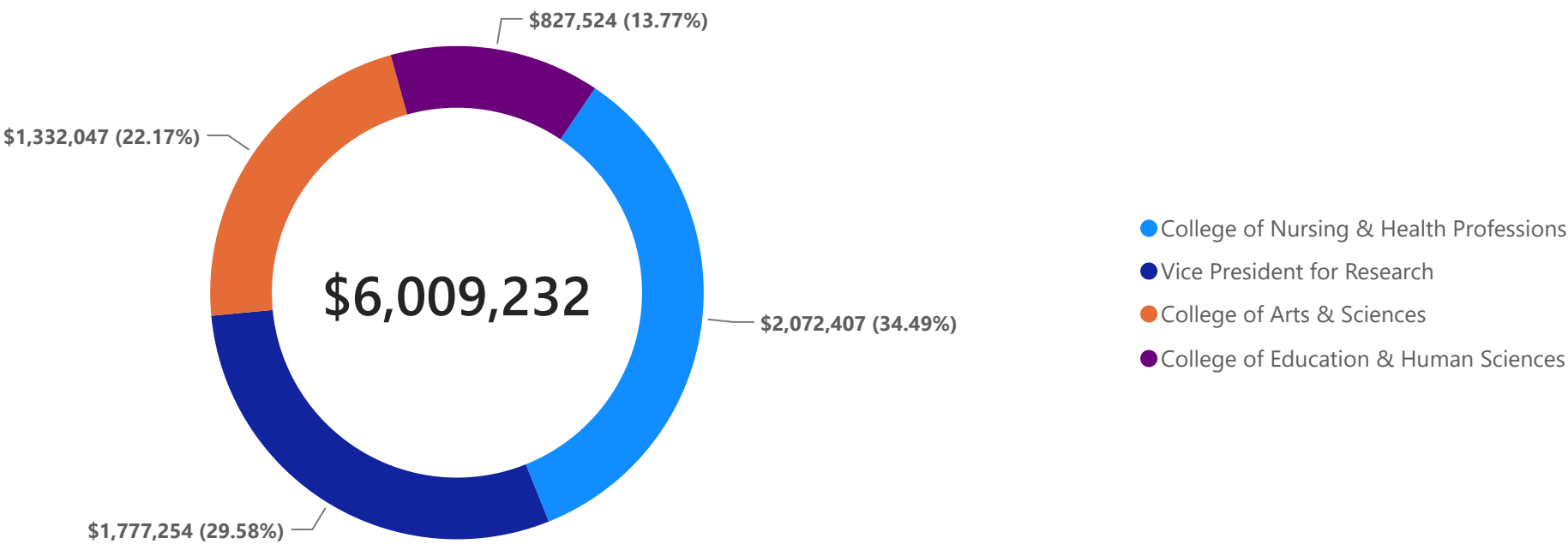

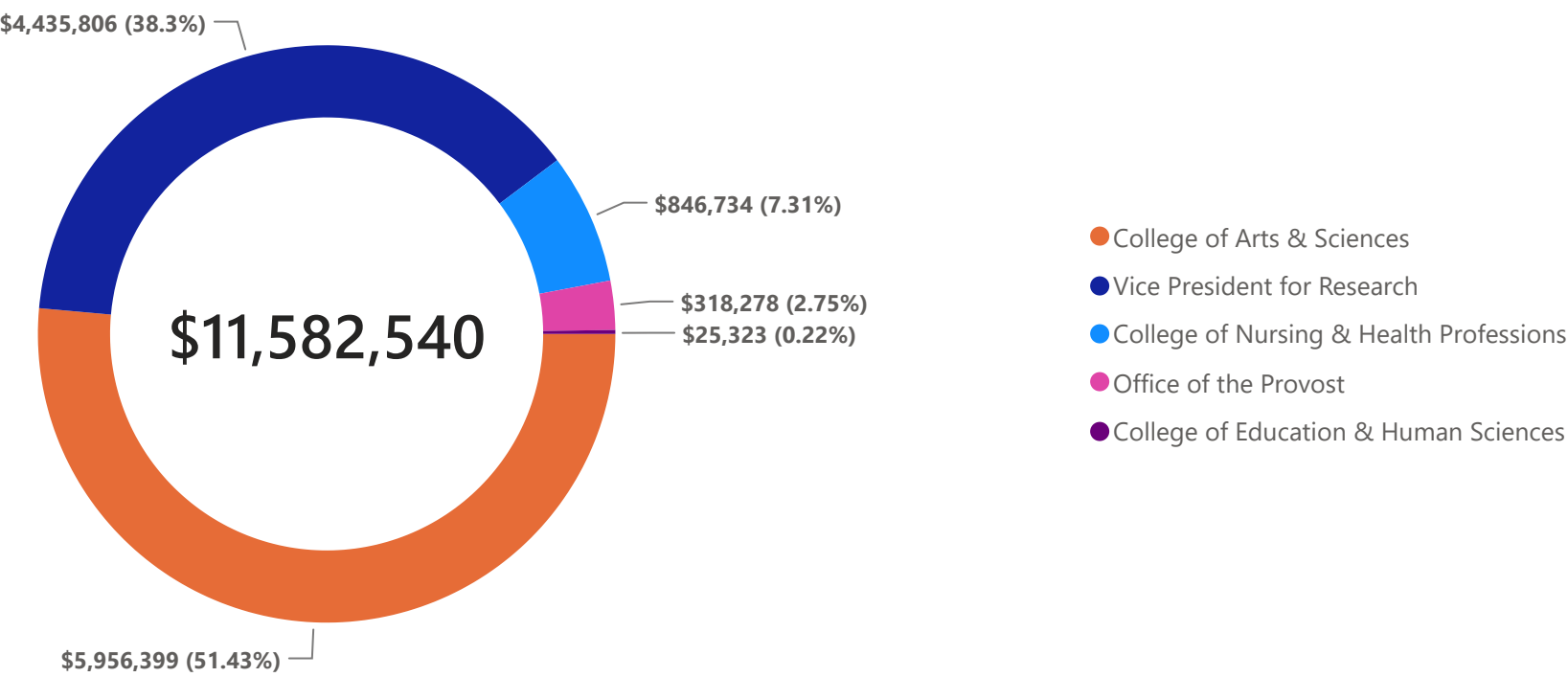
Funded Totals by College - YoY

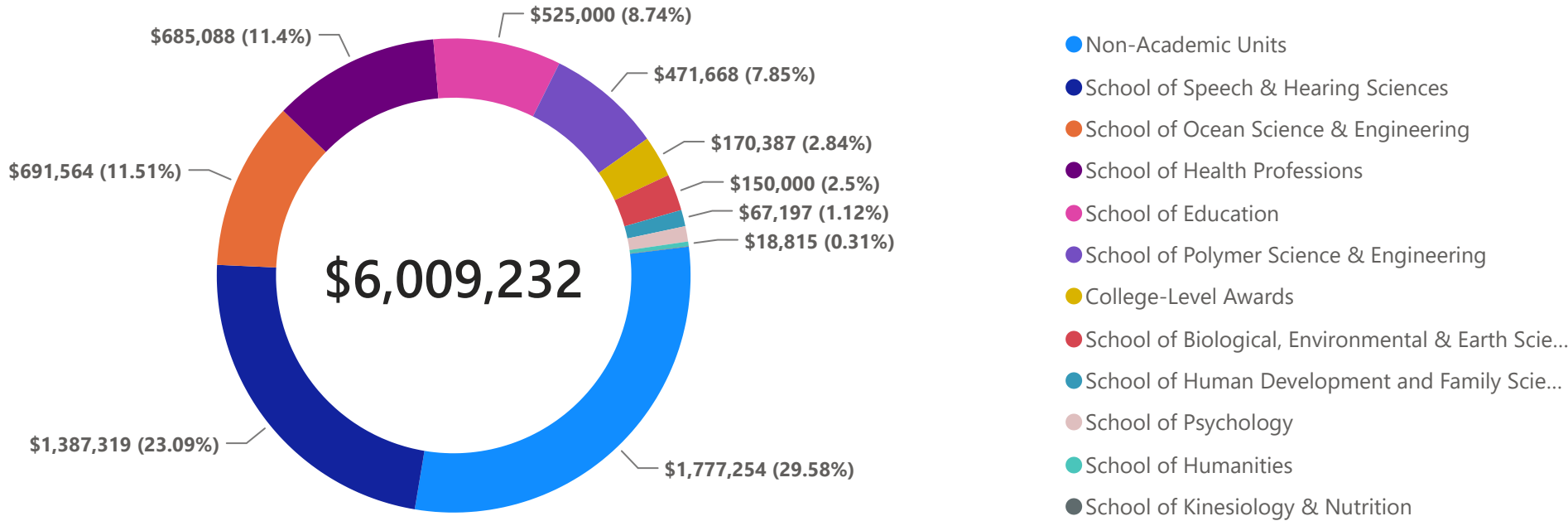

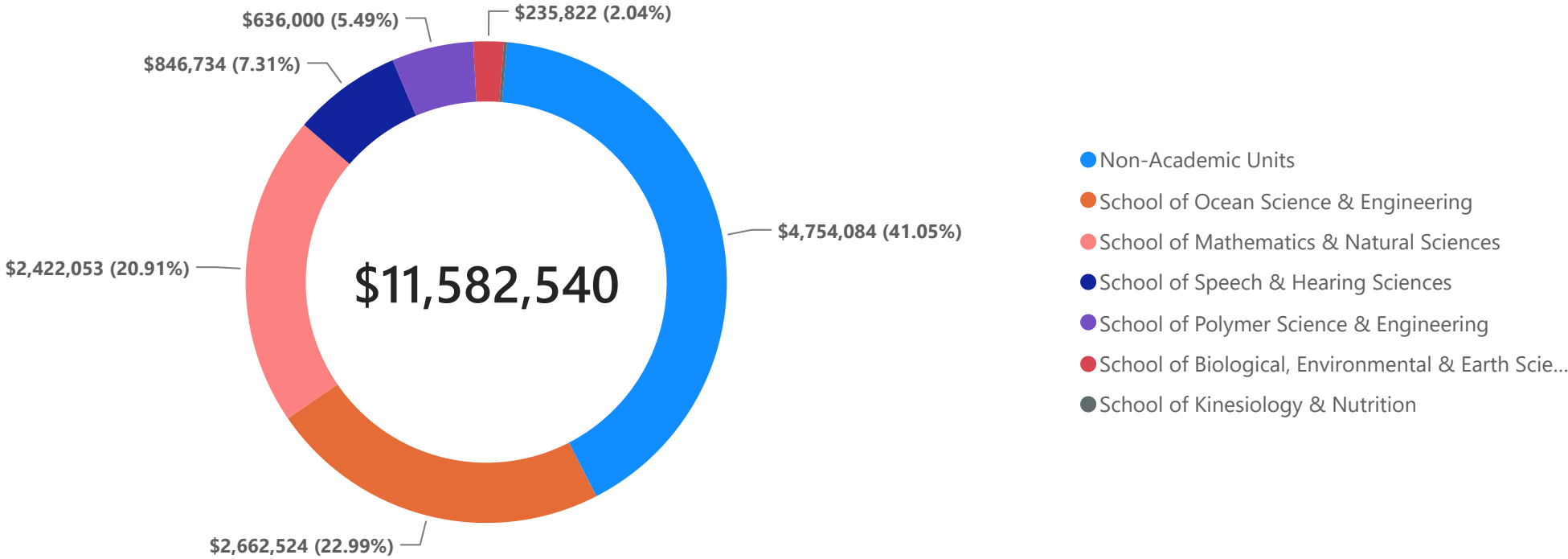
Funded Totals by School - YoY

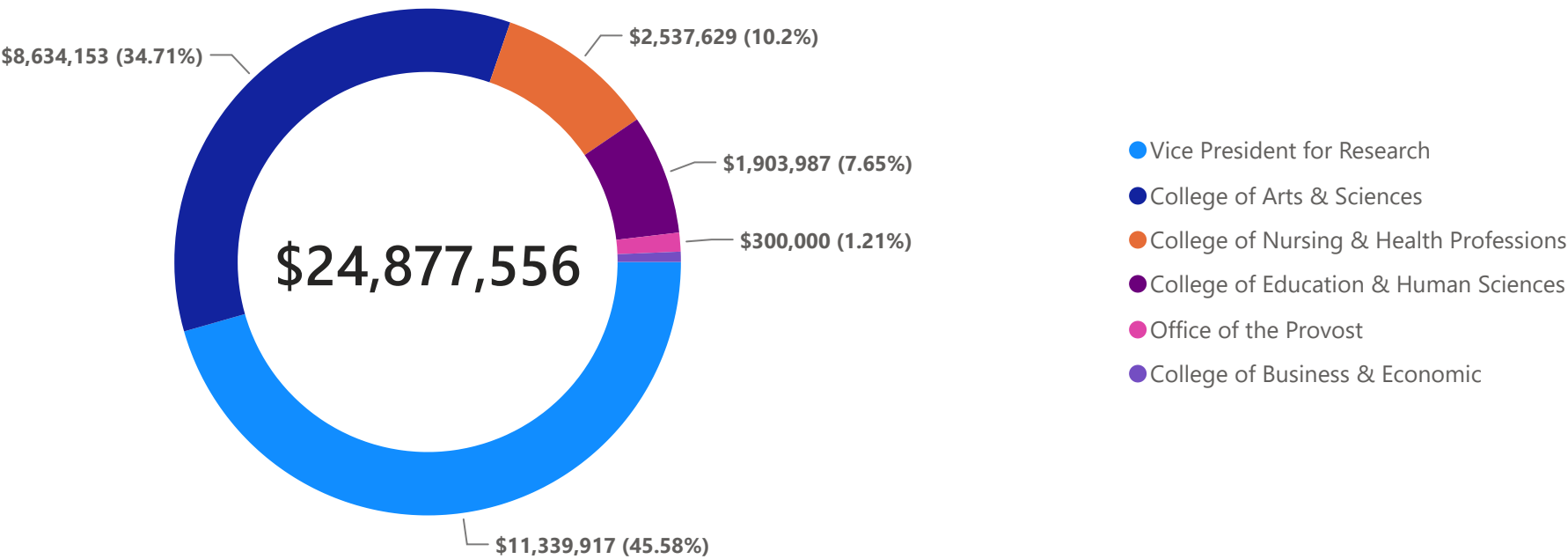

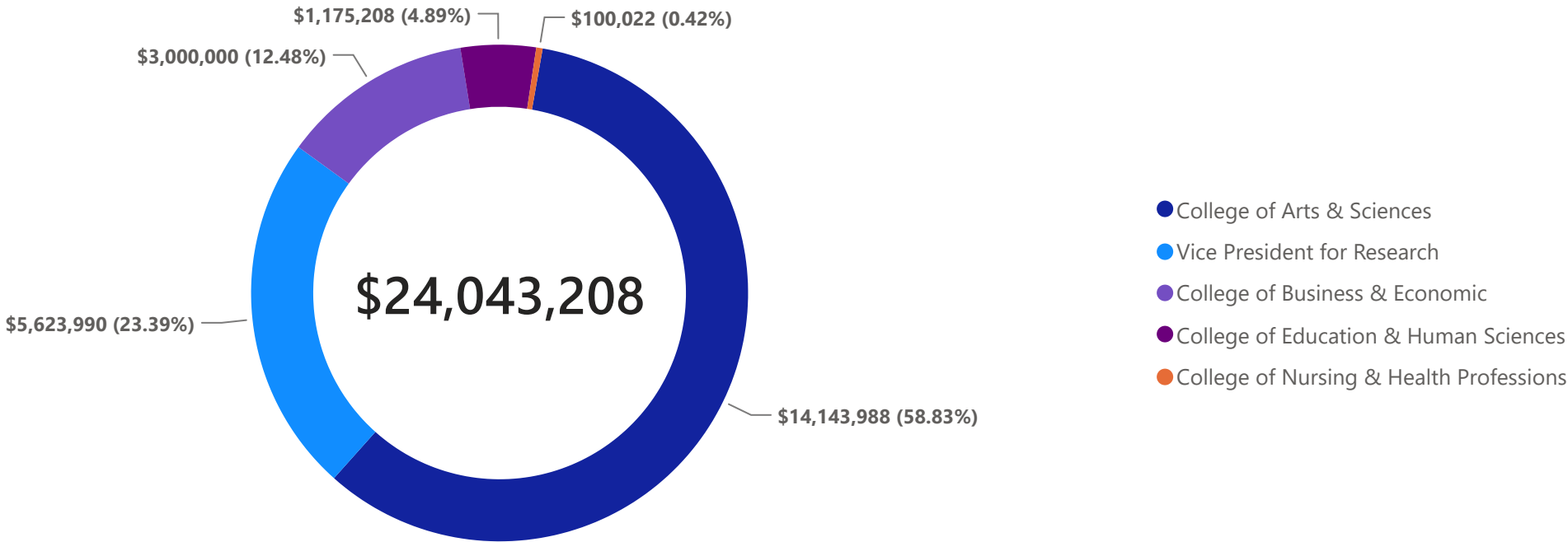

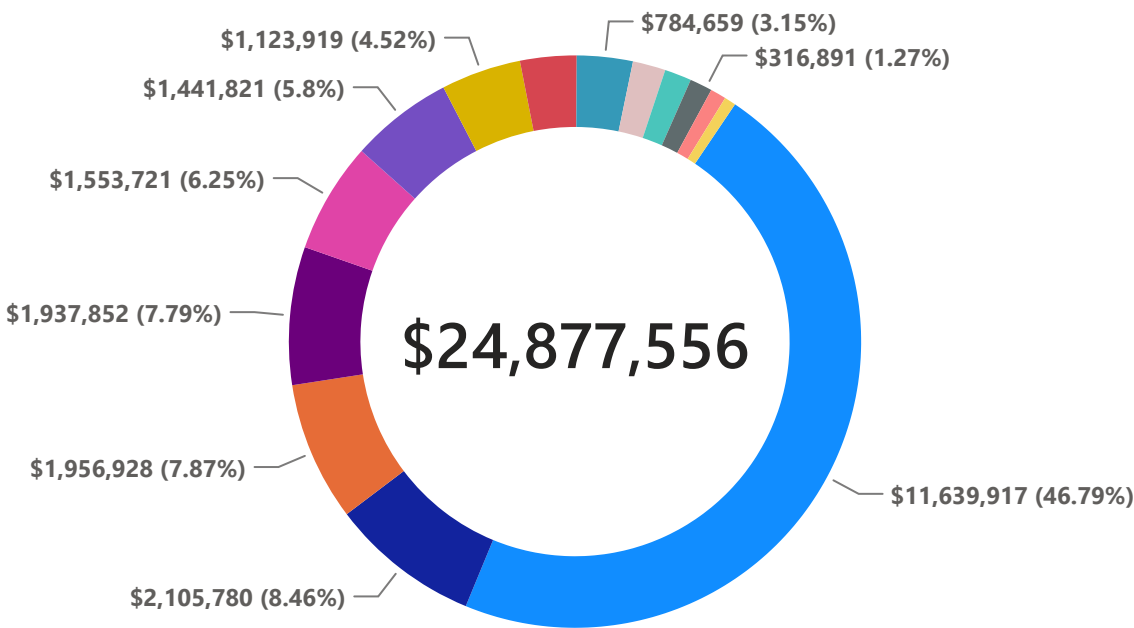

Proposal Requested Amounts by School - YoY

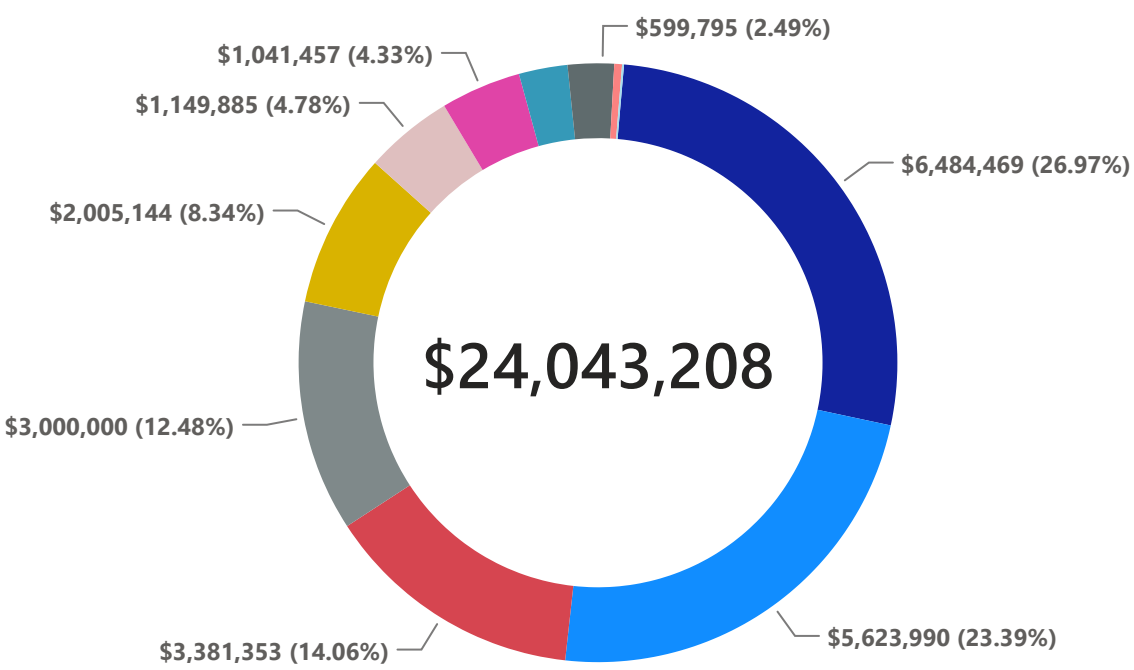
