

## **HUMAN SUBJECTS RESEARCH AT USM: GETTING STARTED**

- 1. Use your institutional login information (<u>FirstName.Lastname@usm.edu</u>) to create a CITI account at CITI Institutional Login.
  - a. **All investigators** must complete the Common Course AND the Human Subjects Research CITI modules every 5 years.
  - b. Faculty, Staff, and Postdoctoral Fellows involved in human or animal subjects research submitted to the USM Institutional Review Board (IRB) and/or Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) must also complete the Conflict of Interest, Research Security, and Export Control CITI modules every 4 years.
  - c. **Undergraduate and Graduate Students** working on research projects funded by federal grants or contracts must also complete the Conflict of Interest, Research Security, and Export Control CITI modules every 4 years.
  - d. Download and save your CITI certificates → You may need to manually upload them to your IRB protocol if they don't load automatically in InfoEd.
- 2. InfoEd is our online system for IRB submission and review. You should be automatically added to <u>InfoEd</u> (use your "w" number—w123456@usm.edu to log in), but if not, go <u>here</u> to complete this form to be added manually.
  - After you have completed the form to be added, please allow a minimum of 3 working days to access the system. If, after 3 working days, you are not able to access the system, email RISGA@usm.edu.
- 3. If you are a student (undergraduate or graduate), you must complete <u>this training</u> and upload the certificate to each IRB protocol you submit in InfoEd.
- 4. Sample templates for documents you may need as a part of your IRB application are available here.
