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


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Hi, sophomore!

- Set and adjust to a schedule (sleeping and work)
- Gather materials needed for notetaking in class
 - Invest in a planner
- 💭 Check your USM email daily
- Know who your faculty advisor is
- Pay bill/sign up for payment plan
 - Accept awards/scholarships
