#### **GET ORGANIZED**

## **GET TO KNOW YOUR PROFESSORS**

Your professors are one of your greatest resources for success. Identify each of your professor's office hours and try to go to each of their office hours during the first few weeks of classes.



### FIND YOUR IDEAL STUDY ZONE

Find a quiet place with limited distractions to complete study sessions and class assignments. Be sure to check out the **Cook Library**, R.C Cook Union, or the Courtyard!



#### **CONNECT WITH CLASSMATES**

Study groups can be a great way to explore challenging course concepts in a supportive environment. Try to build relationships with your classmates by arriving to class a few minutes early or staying after class to meet your peers.



### **GET YOUR TEXTBOOKS ASAP!**

Not having your textbooks during the first week can put you behind. If you opt into the **Eagle Direct Textbooks** program, verify your order 30 days before **classes start** and pick up your books prior to the first day of class.



## **EXPLORE CAMPUS RESOURCES**

### FIND HEALTHY STRESS RELIEF
