### Obama signs \$10.8B highway bill



President Obama on Friday signed a \$10.8 billion measure that will fund highway and bridge repairs for the next ten months.

The short-term measure, approved by lawmakers last month, is paid for using a budgeting maneuver called pension smoothing, which allows corporations to reduce their contributions to employee retirement plans. By allowing companies to do so, the

government can boost tax revenues since companies are no longer eligible for tax deductions.
